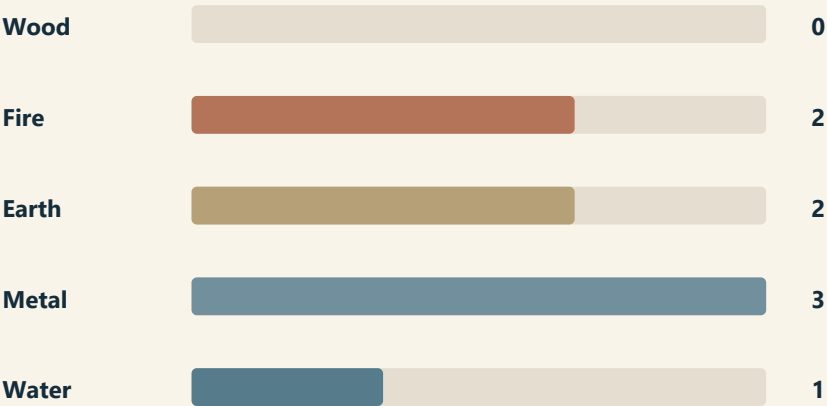

Your Day Master is Geng, Yang Metal. Corrected solar time is approximately 14:01; the hour pillar remains Gui Wei. These fictional details are used consistently throughout this book.

Four pillars are a starting point, not a verdict.

ELEMENTAL LANDSCAPE

What is visible. What is not.



Counts of the eight visible symbols: 3 Metal, 2 Fire, 2 Earth, 1 Water and 0 Wood. This is not a strength score or a personality percentage. Seasonal context and hidden stems add other layers.

Wood is absent from the visible pillars but present within Chen and Wei. Metal is numerically prominent; that alone does not establish a strong or weak Day Master.

A simple chart should not erase a subtle distinction.

YOUR DAY MASTER

Strength with a purpose.

Geng, Yang Metal, is your Day Master: the point from which this chart's other symbols are interpreted. Our image is a well-made tool. Its value lies in what it helps accomplish, not in how imposing it looks.

The visible year stem repeats Geng, while the month stem is Xin, another Metal stem. This gives the reading a clear theme of standards, comparison and definition. You might explore the moments when you notice a flaw before anyone else has named it. Is your observation making a shared task clearer, or making it harder to begin?

The Si month adds an early-summer Fire setting. Traditionally, Fire regulates Metal. Read this as a question about pressure: which expectations help refine a skill, and which only keep you on edge? A standard becomes constructive when someone can understand it, act on it and know when the task is complete.

A clear standard should make the next step easier to see.

LOVE & PARTNERSHIP

Clarity, with warmth.

The day branch, Chen or Dragon, is traditionally read as the relationship palace. Its Earth character adds a support-and-stability theme to this reading. Rather than predicting a partner, use it to examine what makes a relationship feel dependable in practice.

For the supplied traditional female convention, Fire belongs to the partner-star category relative to Geng Metal. Fire is already visible in the birth chart, independently of any future year. That symbolism does not establish a person's orientation, partner's gender or relationship status.

One useful question is whether dependability has become an unspoken expectation. If you offer practical help, explain the affection behind it. If you need reliability, describe the action that would demonstrate it. "Please let me know when plans change" is easier to answer than "You should know what matters to me."

Being understood often begins with being specific.

2030 / GENG XU

Change the structure thoughtfully.

The Metal Dog year clashes with the natal Dragon in the day branch. It also brings the Dog into the Ox-Goat pattern spanning the current decade and natal hour, forming the complete three-branch punishment pattern in this calculation system.

These are names for symbolic tensions, not predictions of punishment in everyday life. The reflection theme is structural adjustment: how a close commitment, a private plan and a wider responsibility can compete for the same time or attention.

Before making a major change, describe the problem in practical terms. What is no longer working? Which facts are confirmed? What could be tested reversibly? For relationship questions, speak with the people involved; for consequential financial or legal decisions, use qualified advice. The chart does not establish that something must end. It offers a reason to examine an arrangement carefully rather than react to a dramatic label.
